### EMERGENCIES

In case of an Emergency (accident/illness or otherwise):

- 1) **Please Call Michele Rielly at 864-386-7594.**
- 2) If she does not pick up, please call the closest emergency vet\* to see if they recommend coming in asap. If they say yes, then go there. If otherwise, please follow the vet's advice and let a CaPR employee know.
- 3) If advised to bring the dog into the nearest emergency vet, call any other contact you have at CaPR (Canine Partners of the Rockies), and/or call Michele again.
- 4) Once the dog is seen by the vet, call Michele again to discuss options with the vet on the phone or call your other CaPR contact as instructed by Michele.
- 5) \*You should know of your nearest emergency vet before a CaPR pup arrives in your home.\*
